Dear Professionals,

Season's greetings to all of you.

What to write for the newsletter was a million-dollar question staring at me. Finally I zoomed on to 'How libraries touch lives' and when I googled, I hadn't expected this any way - to my surprise, I found that there is actually an 'I Love My Librarian' award, instituted by Carnegie Corporation of New York / New York Times! Unbelievable!



And there is more to it - it is an initiative of the American Library Association (I can virtually hear some of you asking, if ALA can do it, why can't KLA? Yes, why not?). The nominations are sent by library supporters / users. Recipients are selected for their "dedicated public service and the valuable role they play in the nation's communities in transforming lives through education." Every year the accomplishments of 10 exceptional public, school, college, community college, or university librarians are recognized by their library users and they receive cash award, two plaques (one for the winner and one for the winner's library) and a travel stipend to attend the awards ceremony at New York. Great!

Equally interesting was **Living Stories**, **Living Libraries** - a digital storytelling initiative launched in collaboration with the American Library Association, part documentary, part art-project, and part advocacy and awareness tool. The blog shows, through photo stories, how libraries impact people's lives in a meaningful way.

And finally, a warm letter by a teacher to the American Library Association in 2014, showing how libraries and librarians make a difference. For Veteran's Day, James Whittaker's **We Thought We Heard the Angels Sing** (a book about soldiers

during WWII who survived a plane crash over the Pacific and were stranded on a life raft for weeks) had taken Suzanne Kelly and her students on a pursuit of knowledge that connected them with the WWII veterans from the book. These veterans became a part of the students' lives for years to come. With the help of librarians, historians, and archivists who shared the students' curiosity and provided the catalysts for learning, subsequent classes of sixth graders could succeed in reuniting the survivors and some of their rescuers! Kelly wanted to thank the librarians: "Some of the seeds that I talked about librarians planting, I have seen come to

harvest....I am contacting as many reference librarians as I can who helped us in 1985 to let them know they made a difference in our lives and in the lives of many other people..." All these finally boil down to one simple truth: libraries do change lives. And there are any no. of people out there who will vouchsafe for that. As the Declaration for the Right to Libraries puts it, library users do benefit from the expert teaching and guidance of librarians and library staff to help expand their mind and open new worlds.

Of course, there are times when we librarians feel despondent at not getting our due recognition. Everyone seems to know what librarians can and also what they do; yet, they are slow in recognizing it. Can we then say: let's adopt the principle of the Gita, *karmanyavadhikarasthe ma phaleshu kadachana*? Let us focus on empowering ourselves, no matter what people say or don't say; let us promote the value of libraries and librarians.

Kerala Library Association is committed to improving the quality of libraries and librarians. Our Continuous Professional Development Centre is one such attempt of ours to bring about qualitative change and improvement among the library professionals. We are also organizing workshops / seminars / conferences to bring people together, to make interaction easier and transfer of knowledge simpler and speedy. We hope you will all make use of the opportunity and also give valuable suggestions to us about how to move forward.

The seminar on New Information Technology Interfaces in Libraries and Information Centres was organized by Kerala Library Association, supported by Raja Rammohun Roy Foundation (RRRLF), Kolkata and cosponsored by Kerala State Council for Science, Technology & Environment (KSCSTE), Government of Kerala., held from 12 to 13 July 2013 at Seminar Hall of Kerala State Science & Technology Museum, Thiruvananthapuram.

The seminar was inaugurated by Dr. V. N. Rajasekharan Pillai, Executive Vice-President, Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Engineering. Dr. A. K M Govi (85), bibliographer and former Editor of the National Library in Kolkata, died at his residence at Thalassery. Considered as an authority on Library Science in the country, Govi was associated with the National Library for long before retiring as its Bibliography Editor. From 1956 to 1987 worked in Indian National Bibliography at Central

Reference Library in National Library, Calcutta. Based on his experiences he wrote 'Library Science' the first book on that subject in Malayalam language. Govi also documented Kerala's literary heritage by painstakingly compiling 10-volume "Malayala Granthasoochi", a comprehensive index of books published in the language. It was published by Sahithya Akademi in print which runs into almost ten volumes and more than 10000 pages is a monumental documentation of the books published in Malayalam up to 1995.
